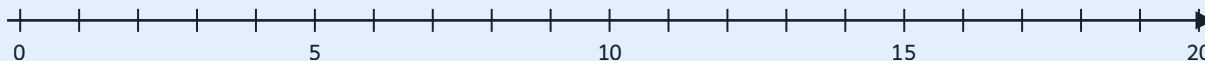


# Mental addition strategies within 100

MODULE 2 · THE FOUR OPERATIONS – MENTAL AND WRITTEN NUMBER

## TRY IT ON THE LINE

Use the number line to place, count and round the numbers in the lesson.



1. Mark each number from the lesson with a small cross.
2. Count on (or back) in equal steps and label where you land.
3. For a rounding task, mark the two nearest tens and ring the closer one.

## PRACTICE

- 1 The Camogie club has **570** sliotars in the storeroom at the start of the season. By the end of training under the floodlights, **249** sliotars have been used or lost in the long grass. How many sliotars are left in the storeroom?
- 2 The school tuck shop sold **249** packets of biscuits in September and **570** packets in October. How many packets did the tuck shop sell in total over the two months?

## CHALLENGE

- 1 At the GAA county final in Croke Park, **3386** supporters travel from Cork and **8528** supporters travel from Galway. How many supporters from the two counties are at the match in total?
- 2 The school library has a target of reading **8528** books across all classes this year. By Easter, the pupils have logged **3386** books read. How many more books do they need to read to reach the target?
