- 2 4th class collect 967 autumn leaves for an art display about the woods at Glendalough. They use 695 of the leaves to make a big mural on the noticeboard. How many leaves are left over?

- 1** For an autumn art lesson, 4th class collect **249** leaves from the school yard each day for **9** days. How many leaves do they collect in total?

- 2 The 4th class book fair sold 80 paperbacks during the week. The sales were spread evenly across 4 days. How many paperbacks were sold each day?
