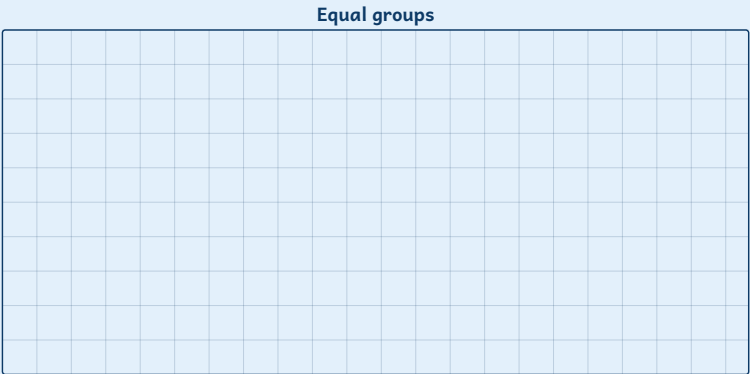


Division with remainders – a first look

TRY IT ON THE LINE

Share the counters into equal groups, then read off how many in each group and what is left over.



- 1. Draw the right number of group circles and deal the dots in equally.
- 2. Ring any leftover and write it as the remainder.
- 3. Write each answer as a number sentence.

PRACTICE

1 At the 4th class book fair, Aoife has **54** bookmarks to share equally between **9** stalls. How many bookmarks does each stall get?

2 Cian is drawing the school yard for an art lesson. He has a strip of paper that is **32 cm** long, and he wants to mark it into sections of **3 cm** each for the yard's paving lines. How many full **3 cm** sections can he mark, and how many centimetres are left over?

32 ÷ 3 = ? Give the answer and the remainder.

CHALLENGE

1 Cian has **78** counters to share equally between **4** grid-paper battleship boards at indoor break. He places the same number of counters on each board. How many counters go on each board, and how many are left over?

78 ÷ 4 = ? Give the answer and the remainder.

2 The 4th class cake sale raises **€108** for the Junior Infants' new playground. The money is shared equally between **4** pieces of playground equipment. How much is spent on each piece?
