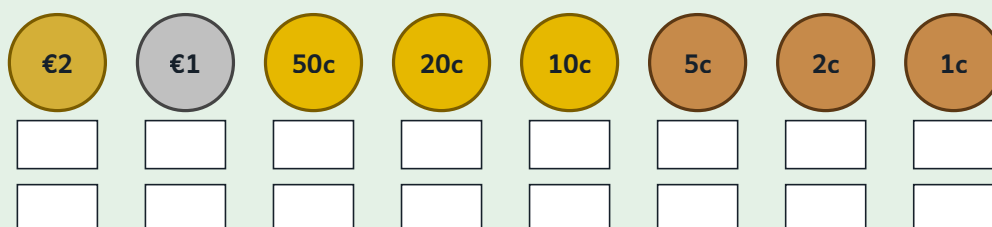
HOW TO ANSWER TODAY

- **Make change.** Change = what you paid – what it cost.

Paid €10, cost €6.75 → €10 – €6.75 = €3.25
