

Building a class budget

MODULE 5 · TIME AND MONEY NUMBER

€100 CLASS-PARTY BUDGET

- 1 The class agrees: **half** for food, **a quarter** for drinks, the rest for decorations.
- 2 **Food:** $1/2$ of €100 = **€50**. **Drinks:** $1/4$ of €100 = **€25**.
- 3 **Decorations:** €100 – €50 – €25 = **€25**.
- 4 Check: €50 + €25 + €25 = **€100**. ✓

HOW TO ANSWER TODAY

- **Make change.** Change = what you paid – what it cost.
Paid €10, cost €6.75 → €10 – €6.75 = €3.25
