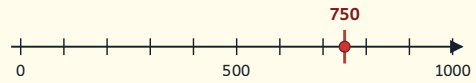


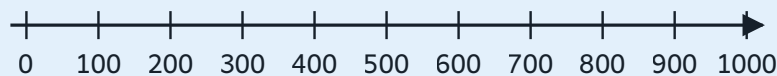
PLACING 750 ON A 0-1,000 LINE

- ① The line runs from 0 to 1,000, so the middle landmark is 500.
- ② 750 is bigger than 500, so it sits between 500 and 1,000.
- ③ 750 is halfway from 500 to 1,000, so mark it in the middle of that half.



WARM-UP

Mark each metre reading in roughly the right place on the sponsored-walk number line.



1. Mark 88 and 250 in the first half of the line
2. Mark 500 exactly on the middle landmark
3. Mark 640 between the middle and the finish
