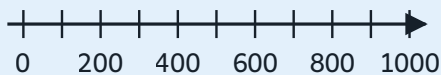


PLACING 480 ON THE LINE

- 1 Spot the hundred marks around 480: **400** and **500**.
- 2 480 is 80 past 400, so it sits most of the way toward **500**.
- 3 Mark an arrow a little to the left of the **500** landmark and label it 480.

 WARM-UP

Mark the GAA scores on the blank 0 to 1,000 number line.



1. Mark and label 250, 550 and 730 with clear arrows
2. Mark and label 150, 480 and 615 with clear arrows
3. Mark and label 300, 820 and 940 with clear arrows

 PRACTICE

- 1 A GAA club scores 300 points in the league. Place 300 on the 0 to 1,000 line.



- 2 The camogie team runs **250 metres** in training. Show where **250** belongs on the line.



- 3** Fans buy **550** match tickets early. Mark **550** on the **0** to **1,000** number line.



- 4 A hurler strikes the sliotar **615** times in practice. Estimate where **615** lands on the line.

- 5** The stadium holds **820** supporters for the big GAA final. Decide which landmark **820** sits nearer.

ALWAYS, SOMETIMES, NEVER

- a. 500 sits exactly in the middle of a 0 to 1,000 number line.
- b. A number ending in 50 sits exactly halfway between two hundred marks.
- c. 820 is closer to 800 than to 900 on the line.
- d. Every number on the 0 to 1,000 line sits exactly on a hundred mark.
