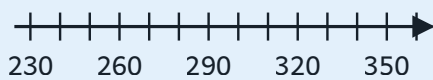


ROLLOVER WHEN ADDING 10 TO 290

- 1 Start at **290** and look at the tens digit.
- 2 The tens digit is already **9**, so it cannot simply climb one more.
- 3 Adding 10 rolls the nine tens into a new hundred: tens become **0** and the hundreds digit rises from **2** to **3**.
- 4 The new number is **300**.

WARM-UP

Mark the given numbers on the blank number line and show the jumps.



1. Mark 240, 250 and 260 on the line
2. Mark 290 and 300 to show the rollover jump
3. Mark 315 and 325 on the line

- 1 At the GAA pitch there were **220** fans ready for the match. Then **10** more fans arrived. How many fans are there now?
- 2 A young runner had already covered **250 metres** in training. She jogged on another **10 metres**. How far has she run in total?
- 3 The tournament scoreboard showed **380** points. After a review the officials took **10** points away. What does the board show now?
- 4 The club had raised **290 euro** for new hurleys. A raffle brought in **10 euro** more. How much money have they raised altogether?
- 5 There were **315** people at the sports day. Then **100** more supporters came for the big GAA final. How many people are there in total?

SPOT THE MISTAKE

Lily works out 10 more than 296 like this:

$$296 + 10 = 2106$$

Lily's answer is wrong. What is 10 more than 296?
