

ADDING 256 APPLES AND 137 APPLES

- Stack 256 over 137 with units under units, tens under tens and hundreds under hundreds.
- Add the units: $6 + 7 = 13$. Write **3** in the units and carry **1** to the tens.
- Add the tens: $5 + 3 + \text{carried } 1 = 9$. Write **9** in the tens.
- Add the hundreds: $2 + 1 = 3$. Write **3** in the hundreds.
- The total is 393.
