

TEN PAIRS OF GAA BOOTS

- 1 See 10 equal groups of boots.
- 2 Each group holds 2 boots.
- 3 Count in twos: 2, 4, 6, 8, 10, 12, 14, 16, 18, 20.
- 4 So $10 \times 2 = 20$ boots altogether.
