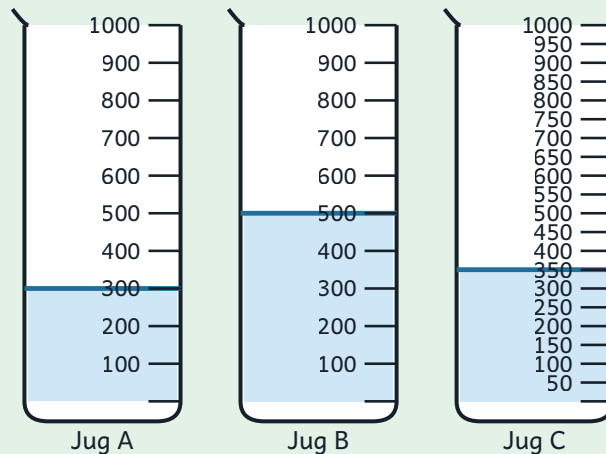


FIND STEP SIZE THEN READ LEVEL

- ① Count the marks between 200 ml and 400 ml: there is one mark so each step is 100 ml
- ② The water stops at the first mark after 200 ml so the reading is 300 ml

WARM-UP

Read each jug at eye level after finding the step size



1. Read Jug A showing steps of 100 ml
2. Read Jug B showing steps of 100 ml
3. Read Jug C showing steps of 50 ml

PRACTICE

- ① In the shop the milk jug is marked **200 ml** and **400 ml** with one mark between so steps of **100 ml** and the water stops at **300 ml**
 | steps of 100 ml, water on 300 ml

- ② Shopping for juice the jug shows marks every **100 ml** from **400 ml** to **600 ml** and the level is at **500 ml**
 | steps of 100 ml, water on 500 ml

- ③ Buying soup the jug is marked every **100 ml** between **200 ml** and **400 ml** but the water is halfway so at **250 ml**
 | steps of 100 ml, water on 250 ml

? ALWAYS, SOMETIMES, NEVER

Always, sometimes or never true? Write A, S or N.

- a. Counting the marks between two numbered lines gives the step size for reading the jug
- b. The water level is read by looking from above the jug
- c. A jug marked 0 200 400 has steps of 100 ml
- d. Halfway between 200 ml and 400 ml is always 250 ml
