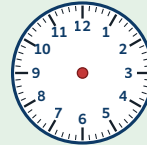
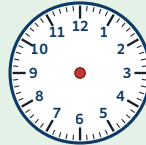


HOW LONG FROM 2 O'CLOCK TO QUARTER PAST 2

- 1 Look at the start time of 2 o'clock with the hour hand on 2 and minute hand on 12.
- 2 Count on to the finish at quarter past 2, where the minute hand reaches the 3.
- 3 The minute hand has moved a quarter of the way round, so 15 minutes have passed.
