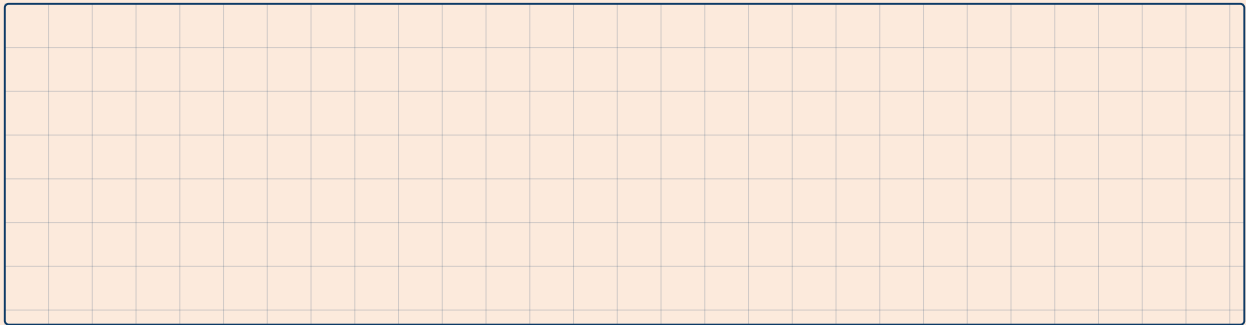


COUNTING THE STOP-SIGN SIDES

- 1 Look at the flat stop-sign shape from the road.
- 2 Tap each straight side one by one all the way round.
- 3 Count **1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8**.
- 4 Eight sides means the shape is an octagon.

IRISH FACT

Hexagons at the Giant's Causeway

Most of the stone columns at the Giant's Causeway in County Antrim are **hexagons** — each one has **6** straight sides that lock tightly against the next column.
