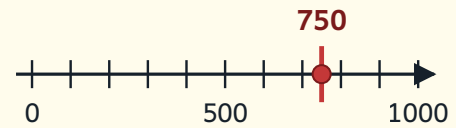


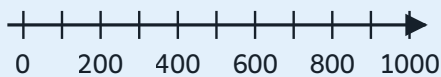
PLACING 750 ON A 0–1,000 LINE

- 1 The line runs from 0 to 1,000, so the middle landmark is 500.
- 2 750 is bigger than 500, so it sits between 500 and 1,000.
- 3 750 is halfway from 500 to 1,000, so mark it in the middle of that half.



WARM-UP

2. Mark the middle landmark of the line and write its value
3. Mark 820 between the middle and the finish

- 4 A footballer has kicked the ball 640 metres down a 1,000 metre training run. Place 640 on the line.
