

TWO-STEP: ADD THEN SUBTRACT

- 1 "Collects" €175 and €168 means join them first: $175 + 168 = 343$.
- 2 "Spends" €240 and "how much is left" means take away: $343 - 240$.
- 3 $343 - 240 = 103$.
