

NAMING THREE TENTHS AS A DECIMAL

- 1 The strip is split into **10** equal parts.
- 2 Three parts are shaded, so the fraction is **$\frac{3}{10}$** .
- 3 Three tenths is the same as the decimal **0.3**.
