

READING €0.75 TWO WAYS

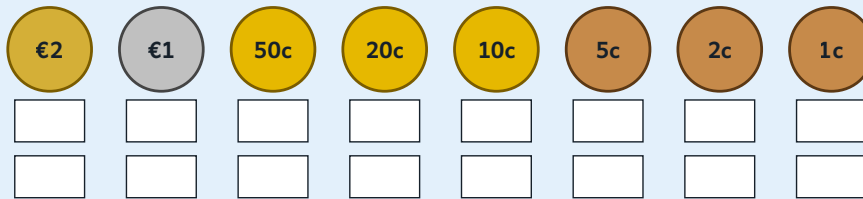
- Look at the digits after the point: **75**. These are the cent.
- There are **100** cent in one euro, so €0.75 is **75** out of **100** cent.
- $€0.75 = 75/100 = 3/4$, three quarters of a euro (see the strip).



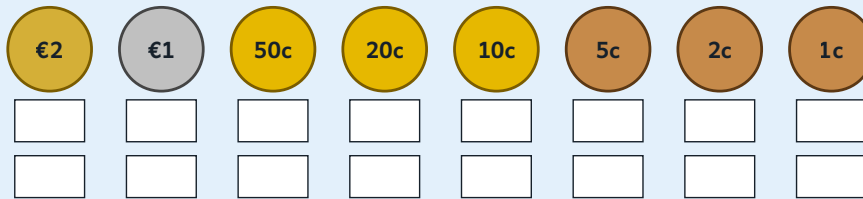
WARM-UP

Show each amount on the coin mat.

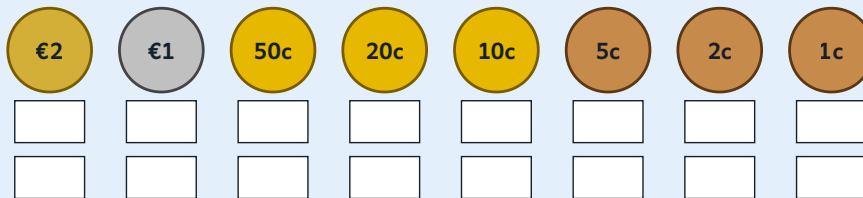
- Write one half of a euro as an amount in cent, then lay out coins to match.
