

TOTALLING A BASKET

- Line up the prices with euro under euro and cent under cent: **€0.45**, **€1.20**, **€1.35**.
- Add the cent column: $5 + 0 + 5 = 10$. Write 0 and carry 1.
- Add the ten-cent column: $4 + 2 + 3 + 1 = 10$. Write 0 and carry 1 euro.
- Add the euro column: $0 + 1 + 1 + 1 = 3$. The total is **€3.00**.
