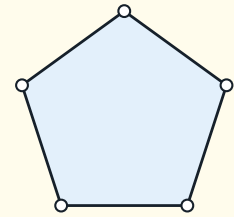


NAMING BY SIDES AND VERTICES

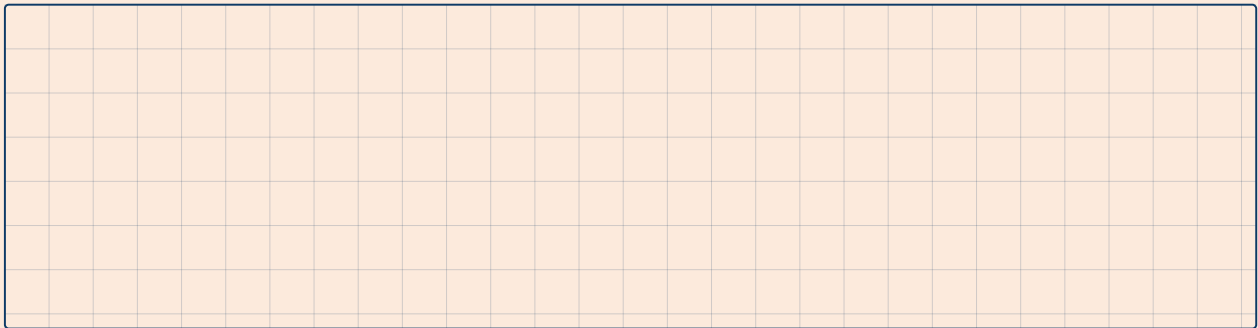
- 1 Count the straight sides on the shape: 5.
- 2 Count the vertices (corners) where the sides meet: 5.
- 3 A flat shape with 5 sides and 5 vertices is called a pentagon.

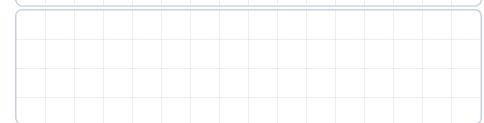
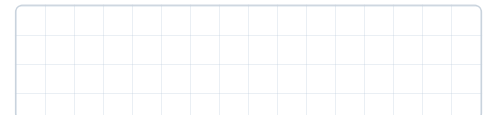
Use the squared space to draw and label these shapes yourself.

IRISH FACT

The shape of a GAA pitch

Every GAA pitch is a **rectangle** — it has **4 straight sides** and **4 vertices**, and a senior pitch is between **130 m and 145 m** long.
