What you need: group bird-feeder prototype from earlier in this project • watering can or large jug with water (pour station) • shallow plastic tray • metre stick • bird seed • tablespoon • paper towels • spare improvement kit (bottle tops, string, lollipop or garden sticks, tape, card offcuts) • scissors • Investigation Journal page

Words to use

Success criteria • Fair test of a prototype • Iteration

The problem

Our feeder did not fully meet one or more success criteria on the first fair test.

First-test feeder scores (in score out of 6)

Group	First-test total (out of 6)

Draw a bar chart of our results

The chosen change is linked to first-test evidence • The feeder is re-tested on all three criteria • New scores are recorded beside the first-test scores • The group can say whether the total improved and why
