What you need: newspaper sheets · card offcuts (from cereal boxes or scrap card) · drinking straws · lolly sticks · masking tape roll · toy car for bridge load test · small weight for tower load test (bag of coins or wooden block) · books or desk gap supports to make a 20–30 cm bridge span · front-table demo kit (newspaper sheet, tape, two supports with the same marked 20–30 cm class gap)
