HOW TO ANSWER TODAY

- **Expanded form (decimals).** Write the decimal as a sum of its parts: ones, tenths, hundredths. Skip any part that is 0.

$$4.52 = 4 + 0.5 + 0.02 \cdot 0.07 = 0.07$$

- 1** Cian is line leader and his 4th-class line measures **5.71 m** long along the corridor wall before going to the yard. Write **5.71** in expanded form, showing the ones, tenths and hundredths parts.

- 2 At the farmers' market in Cork, a punnet of strawberries costs €3.80 and a loaf of brown bread costs €3.08. Which costs more, and how many cent are in each price?
