HOW TO ANSWER TODAY

- **Read an analog clock.** Hour hand (short) → which hour. Minute hand (long) → minutes, counting in 5s.

Hour hand past 10, minute hand on 3 → 10:15

- **12-hour ↔ 24-hour.** 24-hour uses 00–23, no am/pm. For pm times, add 12 to the hour.

3:30 pm → 15:30 · 08:15 → 8:15 am

★ STRETCH PROBLEMS

- 1 Saoirse is waiting at Dublin Airport for her Aer Lingus flight to Spain on a 4th class school exchange. She looks up at the big analog clock in the departures hall: the minute hand points to the **7** and the hour hand sits just past the **3**. What time is it?
