

Telling time to 5-minute intervals (analog)

HOW TO ANSWER TODAY

- **Read an analog clock.** Hour hand (short) → which hour. Minute hand (long) → minutes, counting in 5s.

Hour hand past 10, minute hand on 3 → 10:15

★ STRETCH PROBLEMS

- 1 On the school tour to Glendalough, Cian checks the classroom clock before the bus leaves in the afternoon. The minute hand points to the **2** and the hour hand sits just past the **1**. Write this afternoon time in **24**-hour form.
- 2 Cara looks up at the classroom clock after little break in 4th class. The minute hand points to the **2** and the hour hand sits just past the **3**. Write this afternoon time in **24**-hour form.
- 3 During the class assembly, Oisín looks up at the classroom clock. The minute hand points straight to the **12** and the hour hand points exactly at the **11** that morning. Write this time in **24**-hour form.
- 4 On the class trip from Cork to Dublin, Cian looks at the station clock on the Irish Rail platform in the afternoon. The minute hand points to the **3** and the hour hand sits just past the **2**. Write this time in **24**-hour form.
- 5 Cian looks at the clock on the classroom wall just after the morning bell. The minute hand points to the **2** and the hour hand sits just past the **8**. What time is it?
