Why biodiversity matters

Rs Rs Biodiversity is the variety of living things in a place: plants, animals, fungi and tiny soil organisms

Pollinators in Ireland

Rs Rs Pollinators move pollen so plants can make seeds and fruit

The All-Ireland Pollinator Plan

Rs Rs This is a shared plan across the island of Ireland to help bees and other pollinators recover

Biology and ecosystems

Rs Rs Biology is the science of living things. Ecologists study how living things depend on each other and on their habitat

From facts to action

Rs Rs Useful school-grounds actions: leave a corner unmown, plant pollinator-friendly flowers (such as clover or bird's-foot trefoil where suitable), build a simple bug hotel, or make a small log pile
