



The main organs of the human body

3rd Class

Print and cut along the dashed lines, then hand one card to each group. These carry the **text a group reads** — a job to do, a brief to research, or notes to identify by. They are not sorted or sequenced, so there is nothing to match on screen.

Brain

Soft and wrinkly-looking. Sits inside the head.
Job: thinks, remembers and tells the body what to do. ^{Rs} ^{Rs}

Heart

About the size of a fist. Sits in the chest, a little to the left. Job: pumps blood around the body. ^{Rs} ^{Rs}

Lungs

Two soft bags. Sit in the chest on either side of the heart. Job: take in air and pass oxygen into the blood. ^{Rs} ^{Rs}

Stomach

A stretchy bag. Sits in the upper tummy. Job: holds food and starts to break it down. ^{Rs} ^{Rs}

Intestines

Long and coiled. Sit in the lower tummy below the stomach. Job: finish breaking down food and take in the goodness
