Junior Infants

Snail

Soft body and a hard spiral shell. Often under damp leaves or logs. Moves very slowly

Woodlouse

Grey-brown body with many little legs. Lives under stones and logs. May curl up when touched gently

Worm

Long, soft, pinkish-brown body with no legs.
Lives in damp soil under leaves
