📖 📖 Biodiversity is the variety of living things in a place: plants, animals, fungi and tiny soil organisms

📖 📖 Pollinators move pollen so plants can make seeds and fruit

📖 📖 This is a shared plan across the island of Ireland to help bees and other pollinators recover

Biology and ecosystems

📖 📖 Biology is the science of living things. Ecologists study how living things depend on each other and on their habitat

From facts to action

📖 📖 Useful school-grounds actions: leave a corner unmown, plant pollinator-friendly flowers (such as clover or bird's-foot trefoil where suitable), build a simple bug hotel, or make a small log pile
