



# The main organs of the human body

**3rd Class**

Print and cut along the dashed lines. These carry the **text a group reads** — a job to do, a brief to research, or notes to identify by. Check the lesson's teacher notes for how many sets each group needs and how they are used: some lessons hand out one card per group, others sort or sequence a full set.

**Brain**

Soft and wrinkly-looking. Sits inside the head.  
Job: thinks, remembers and tells the body what to do

**Heart**

About the size of a fist. Sits in the chest, a little to the left. Job: pumps blood around the body

**Lungs**

Two soft bags. Sit in the chest on either side of the heart. Job: take in air and pass oxygen into the blood

**Stomach**

A stretchy bag. Sits in the upper tummy. Job: holds food and starts to break it down

**Intestines**

Long and coiled. Sit in the lower tummy below the stomach. Job: finish breaking down food and take in the goodness
