Print and cut along the dashed lines. These carry the **text a group reads** — a job to do, a brief to research, or notes to identify by. Check the lesson's teacher notes for how many sets each group needs and how they are used: some lessons hand out one card per group, others sort or sequence a full set.

Heather (wet bog)

Small tough leaves and tiny purple or pink flowers. Likes wet, windy bog ground

Hawthorn (field edge)

Lobed leaves, white spring blossom and sharp thorns. Grows along hedgerows and field edges

Thrift / sea pink (windy shore)

Low cushions of narrow leaves and pink pom-pom flowers. Stays low so strong sea winds do not snap it
