Print and cut along the dashed lines. These carry the **text a group reads** — a job to do, a brief to research, or notes to identify by. Heather (wet bog)

Small tough leaves and tiny purple or pink flowers. Likes wet, windy bog ground. ^{R_s} ^{R_s}

Hawthorn (field edge)

Lobed leaves, white spring blossom and sharp thorns. Grows along hedgerows and field edges. ^{R_s} ^{R_s}

Thrift / sea pink (windy shore)

Low cushions of narrow leaves and pink pom-pom flowers. Stays low so strong sea winds do not snap it
