ANSWER KEY

- a) Equal slices only — the bottom number tells you how many.
- b) The top number tells you how many to shade.
- c) Check: shaded parts / total parts.

Q1: $6 \frac{2}{3} = \frac{6}{9}$

Q2: $5.9 < 9.84$

Q3: $\frac{1}{5} < \frac{3}{4} < \frac{7}{8} < \frac{11}{12}$

Q4: 57

EXTENSION SHEET · STRETCH ANSWERS

S1: $4.8 < 7.32 < 9.84$

S2: 12 parts ($\frac{4}{5} = \frac{12}{15}$)

S3: 9 (tenths digit of 2.9)

S4: $15 \frac{3}{4} = \frac{15}{20}$

S5: 8
