

Tenths – the first decimal place

ANSWER KEY

a) Each digit sits in its own column; line them up on the right.

b) A digit's value = the digit $\times$ its column.

c) Largest: biggest digit on the left; smallest: smallest non-zero digit on the left.

Q1: $5.71 = 5 + 0.7 + 0.01$

Q2: €4.90 (€4.09 = 409 cent; €4.90 = 490 cent)

Q3: €1.75 (write both as cent: 130 cent vs 175 cent)

Q4: $4.8 < 7.32 < 9.84$

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S1: 9 (tenths digit of 2.9)

S2: $6.96 = 6 + 0.9 + 0.06$

S3: €3.80 (€3.80 = 380 cent; €3.08 = 308 cent)
