

Mass – weighing in g and kg

WHAT THIS LESSON TEACHES

Mass is how heavy something is, measured on a weighing scale. Use **grams (g)** for small things and **kilograms (kg)** for big ones. **1 kg = 1 000 g**.

→ A **€2 coin** weighs about **9 g**.

→ A **bag of sugar** weighs **1 kg** (= 1 000 g).

→ A **5th-class schoolbag with books** typically weighs **3–5 kg**.
