

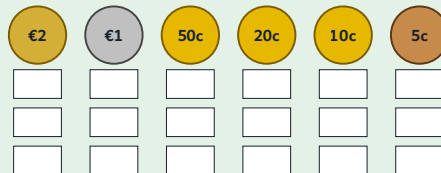
Lesson 65 MEASURES

Operations with money in decimal form

WHAT THIS LESSON TEACHES

Money is written in **euro and cent** as a decimal with **two places**. Line up the points to add or subtract.

Make EUR 4.50 and EUR 3.75



→ €4.50 + €3.75 = **€8.25**.

→ €1.20 and €1.02 are **not** the same amount.

MODEL THIS ON THE BOARD

ADD €4.50 + €3.75

$$\begin{array}{r} 4 \overset{1}{.} 50 \\ + 3 75 \\ \hline 8 25 \end{array}$$

- 1 Line up the decimal points (and the euro signs).
- 2 $0 + 5 = 5$; $5 + 7 = 12$ (write 2, carry 1); $4 + 3 + 1 = 8 \rightarrow$ **€8.25**.
