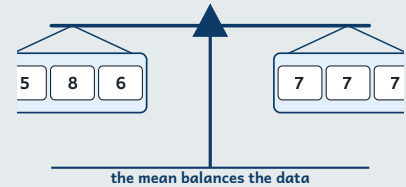


The mean as a measure of centre

WHAT THIS LESSON TEACHES

The **mean** (average) is found by **adding all the values and dividing by how many there are**.

→ Mean of 4, 6, 8, 10 = $28 \div 4 = 7$.



MODEL THIS ON THE BOARD

FIND THE MEAN OF 5, 8, 6, 9, 7

- ① Add them up: $5 + 8 + 6 + 9 + 7 = 35$.
- ② Divide by how many (5): $35 \div 5 = 7$.

W2: 8

Q3: 34.5

Q1: 17

Q4: 35.5
