

KA1 Workshop Part 2: Polish Format 2

60 minutes

ICT Specialism 2: The Presentation of ideas

WHAT THIS LESSON DOES

In this workshop you finalise the second presentation format for your Something Real project. Apply a polish checklist to make it publication ready and different from format one. Both formats should then be ready for teacher verification.

CURRICULUM OUTCOMES

WHAT STUDENTS SHOULD BE ABLE TO DO

- Finalise the second digital presentation format
- Bank Specialism Module 2 Key Assignment 1 with two different formats
- Confirm both formats meet best-practice techniques from the module

BEFORE THE BELL

- Run a pre-class draft roll-call: know each student's format 2 type and whether a draft exists
- Copy fallback templates into sm2 in advance (blank Canva one-pager link and short vertical explainer outline) so door recovery stays under two minutes
- Prepare a non-student sample presentation for the demonstration, with one planned hierarchy fix and one accessibility fix, plus 30-second verbal anchors for video and audio if those media are in the room
- Print the five-item must-do polish checklist for desks
- Have the bankable checklist, visible verification queue order, and written next-step slip pad ready
- Pre-class draft roll-call list of every student's format 2 type and file status; fallback templates already copied into sm2 (blank Canva one-pager link and short explainer outline); SM2 KA1 bankable checklist and visible verification order; projector ready for one quick polish demo; next-step slip pad ready before Portfolio Build
- Optional: one weak vs one strong format 2 example on screen (strip personal student data)
- Sample format 2 for live polish demo with one planned hierarchy fix and one accessibility fix, plus 30-second verbal anchors for video and audio if those media are in the room; printed five-item must-do checklists on desks; list of students' declared format 2 types from earlier in the module
- KA1 verification checklist, class tracking sheet, visible queue order, and written next-step slip pad ready before this block starts
- Update KA tracker after class

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HOW THE LESSON RUNS

5 min	introduction	Introduction

TEACHING MOVES

- Cap the polish demo at 4 minutes; project the five must-dos; name hierarchy and accessibility moves for slides/Canva, video, and audio
- End the polish block at the mid-checkpoint (purpose + hierarchy/access basics + export started); keep final export naming and bankable stamp for Portfolio Build
- Circulate during the workshop; hit video/audio export paths first; address file location issues early
- Use batch verification: students pin both files open, walk row order with a 30-40 second checklist pass, second stop only for problem files
- Run reflection only for students already bankable

WHAT TO WATCH FOR

- Format 2 is too similar to format 1 - change the medium or rebuild the opening
- Difficulty locating files - direct students to check their sm2 folder immediately
- Over-focusing on cosmetics before confirming distinct formats - prioritise structure differences
- Publication file saved in a nested sub-folder - bankable copy must sit directly in sm2
- Canva/video/audio students stall on rename or upload - point them at the numbered Publication paths for their medium

DIFFERENTIATION

- Support: Printed five-item must-do polish checklist on desks at the start of the polish workshop
- Support: Allow extra time for file organisation before starting the polish pass
- Extension (after sign-off only): handover note or honest one-line AI disclosure if AI helped with wording or layout
