Hasta luego	AHS-tah LWEH-goh	See you later
Hasta mañana	AHS-tah mah-NYAH-nah	See you tomorrow
Hasta pronto	AHS-tah PROHN-toh	See you soon
Hasta ahora	AHS-tah ah-OH-rah	See you in a bit
Chao	CHOW	Bye (informal)
Cuídate	KWEE-dah-teh	Take care
Que tengas un buen día	keh TEN-gahs oon bwen DEE-ah	Have a good day

- Adiós — **Goodbye**
- Hasta luego — **See you later**

3 · Put it in order

- ¡Chao! Me voy a casa. — **1**
- ¡Adiós! Hasta mañana. — **2**
- ¡Gracias, hasta pronto! — **4**
- Sí, hasta mañana. ¡Cuídate! — **3**
