SAY IT ALOUD

Bonjour	bohn-ZHOOR	Hello / Good morning
Salut	sah-LOO	Hi (informal)
Bonsoir	bohn-SWAHR	Good evening
Bon après-midi	bohn ah-preh-mee-DEE	Good afternoon
Comment ça va ?	koh-mahn sah VAH	How are you? (informal)
Comment allez-vous ?	koh-mahn tah-lay VOO	How are you? (formal)
Ça va	sah VAH	I'm fine / OK (informal)
Enchanté	ahn-shahn-TAY	Nice to meet you

THE CULTURE POINT

Bonjour to a shopkeeper before anything else — going in silent is rude

Read as written. Pause the board; every pupil writes. Not collected, not marked.

WATCH FOR

- This lesson has both a friendly and a polite form. Pupils tend to use whichever came first for everything.
