- Pupils dropping the little word in front (la, le). It is part of the word, not an extra — mark it as a spelling wherever the page shows it. Match and Crossword print the word on its own, so no article is expected there.
- Accents. 2 of this lesson's words carry one (la règle, le sac à dos). A missing accent is a missing letter.
