SAY IT ALOUD

Adiós	ah-DYOHS	Goodbye
Hasta luego	AHS-tah LWEH-goh	See you later
Hasta mañana	AHS-tah mah-NYAH-nah	See you tomorrow
Hasta pronto	AHS-tah PROHN-toh	See you soon
Chao	CHOW	Bye (informal)
Cuídese	KWEE-deh-seh	Take care (formal)
Buenas noches	BWEH-nahs NOH-chehs	Good night
Cuídate	KWEE-dah-teh	Take care

THE CULTURE POINT

Hasta luego far more than adiós — 'see you later', even to strangers
