COPYBOOK MOMENT · 3 MIN

This is the first meeting with grammatical gender, so go slowly — write the eight fruits with their articles, and put a star beside any whose article surprised you.

Read as written. Pause the board; every pupil writes. Not collected, not marked.

WATCH FOR

- Pupils dropping the little word in front (el, la). It is part of the word, not an extra — mark it as a spelling wherever the page shows it. Word search, Match and Unscramble print the word on its own, so no article is expected there.
- Accents. 3 of this lesson's words carry one (el plátano, el limón, el melocotón). A missing accent is a missing letter.
