WATCH FOR

- Pupils dropping the little word in front (la, le). It is part of the word, not an extra — mark it as a spelling wherever the page shows it. Word search and Unscramble print the word on its own, so no article is expected there.
- Accents. 5 of this lesson's words carry one (la mère, le père, le frère, le grand-père, la grand-mère). A missing accent is a missing letter.
