Water is free on every table if you ask for a carafe

Write the whole café exchange: greeting, order, thank you, goodbye.

Read as written. Pause the board; every pupil writes. Not collected, not marked.

WATCH FOR

- Pupils dropping the little word in front (l', la, le). It is part of the word, not an extra — mark it as a spelling wherever the page shows it. Crossword prints the word on its own, so no article is expected there.
- Accents. 2 of this lesson's words carry one (le café, le thé). A missing accent is a missing letter.
