Las dos	lahs dohs	two o'clock
Las cinco	lahs SEEN-koh	five o'clock
Las diez	lahs dyehs	ten o'clock
Y media	ee MEH-dyah	half past
Y cuarto	ee KWAR-toh	quarter past
Menos cuarto	MEH-nos KWAR-toh	quarter to
En punto	en POON-toh	exactly / on the hour

Time is given in 24 hours on transport, 12 in conversation
