WATCH FOR

- Pupils dropping the little word in front (das, der, die). It is part of the word, not an extra — mark it as a spelling wherever the page shows it. Crossword prints the word on its own, so no article is expected there.
- Accents. 2 of this lesson's words carry one (der Bär, der Löwe). A missing accent is a missing letter.
