COPYBOOK MOMENT · 3 MIN

Write the question that asks to borrow something, and one polite answer that says no.

Read as written. Pause the board; every pupil writes. Not collected, not marked.

WATCH FOR

- Pupils dropping the little word in front (das, der, die). It is part of the word, not an extra — mark it as a spelling wherever the page shows it. Crossword prints the word on its own, so no article is expected there.
- Accents. One of this lesson's words carries an accent (das Federmäppchen). A missing accent is a missing letter.
