## WATCH FOR

- Pupils dropping the little word in front (das, der, die). It is part of the word, not an extra — mark it as a spelling wherever the page shows it. Word search and Unscramble print the word on its own, so no article is expected there.
- ß is a letter, not an accent (der Großvater, die Großmutter). It fills one box and is not written `ss` here.
