Editing Video with Clipchamp, Part 1: Import, Sequence and Trim

WHAT THIS LESSON DOES

Students import three clips into Clipchamp, stack them on separate tracks and trim each to a set length, ending with a saved project that plays in order.

CURRICULUM OUTCOMES

Outcome	What the specification asks for
3.8	create a digital montage on a specific topic of interest from images sourced online while applying learning regarding copyright, fair use, plagiarism, and intellectual property ownership

WHAT STUDENTS SHOULD BE ABLE TO DO

- Import media into a video editor and place it on separate tracks
- Explain what a track, a clip, a trim and a playhead are
- Trim each clip to a set length so picture and sound end together
- Save a named project you can reopen next lesson

BEFORE THE BELL

- Clipchamp needs an account. Students sign in with a Microsoft or Google account, both free, and most schools already issue one. Sort this out before the lesson, because signing up during the period will cost you the practical work. Clipchamp's labels have moved before. The paths given here were correct when this lesson was written, and if a control has moved, the animations still show the action and the panel is in the same place. The clips are supplied and linked from the first step, so students do not film anything. Filming would take a period on its own and is not what this lesson teaches. You do need to make the two demonstration cuts described in the notes on the first step, as those are not supplied.
- Devices with a browser; Clipchamp account.
