WHAT THIS LESSON DOES

Pupils build a web page where visitors type answers into a text box and add them to a list using a button. They add and name the blocks, connect them with an action, test it, and personalise the page.

- Understand the components needed to collect and display visitor input on a web page.
- Learn to use block-based programming to link user input to list updates.
- Develop skills in creating interactive features for personal websites.
